HARLEY RAKE



The original Power Box Rake first designed and built in 1979

The Harley Rake is more of a finessing tool, its ideal uses are Leveling, Grading, Seedbed Preparation, Sloping, Site Preparation, Lawncare, Golf, Wineries, paving and contractors.

DRIVE SYSTEMS

- Single Hydraulic Motor, Indirect Drive.
- Motor located at the top of the Rake away from hazards and soil.
- Self tensioning, shock absorbing chain drive protects the drive system.
- Oil bath enclosed chain drive.

BOX ENDS & JOCKEY WHEELS

- Two position capability in both front and back. Secure Storage point.
- Three connection points for strength and durability.
- Positioned above grade.
- Infinite height adjustments on wheels.
- Fixed Jockey Wheels.

ROLLER & TEETH

- Propriety blunt teeth creates perfect condition surface.
- Bi-directional 6" diameter drum made out of 6" seamless steel round tubing (not pipe).
- Harley has 16 rows of teeth that are helixed slightly around the drum.
- The purpose of the helix tooth design pattern is to give smoother ground engagement and keep material in front of the drum longer in order to clean and process the material better.

POWER RAKE



Was developed by FFC in 2000

The Power Rake is more of a site cleaning tool. The Larger drum and higher torque without the optimum final finish presentation that the Harley Rake offers. Its Ideal for Contractors and Developers.

DRIVE SYSTEMS

- Dual hydraulic motors, eliminates need for chains and sprockets reducing maintained.
- Dual motors delivers 40% more torque to the drum.

BOX ENDS & JOCKEY WHEELS

- Two position capability in both front and back. No Secure Storage point.
- Two connection points for strength and durability.
- Not positioned above grade.
- Fixed height adjustments on wheels.
- Hinged arms on Jockey wheels, easier for transport.

ROLLER & TEETH

- Propriety blunt teeth creates perfect conditioned surface
- Bi-directional 8" diameter drum made out of 8" seamless steel tubing (not pipe).
- Powerrake has 8 straight rows of teeth that are offset around the drum. Requires more teeth because of the larger diameter.
- With a larger drum in the long run you will keep spoil in front of the drum longer. In shorter runs the harley will perform better. It engages more quickly the process of lifting and grinding over the smaller drum diameter.

HARLEY RAKE



FRAME

- Strong tubular frame sits above the roller stopping frame from plowing dirt.
- Slim profile frame allows full depth, first pass penetration.

WHEELS & HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT

- Independent height adjustments upto 75mm.
- Independent height adjustments allows operator to cut drainage grades.
- Quick adjustment levers for quick adjustments.

ANGLE CYLINDER

- Dual side mounted side cylinders aligned with frame.
- Added strength and power when angling

BARRIER

- 6" heavy duty barrier for pushing yet flexible enough to allow damaged debris to pass.
- Fully Adjustable with lift handle.

POWER RAKE



FRAME

- Heavy duty frame to extend life.
- Very Robust.
- Heavy Duty but lighter.

WHEELS & HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT

- Adjustments can be made in limited increments to allow for minimal depth change.
- Easy to adjust front jockey wheels allows for quick adjustments.

ANGLE CYLINDER

- Hydraulic angle, to angle 20° in either direction.
- Single cylinder design to reduce maintain and service.

BARRIER

- Has front and rear barrier fully adjustable.
- 3" Heavy duty barrier to stop debris passing through and protecting the drum
